
# **HOW DOES YANA WORK?**

- Maricopa Police Department Volunteers will make regular telephone calls and visits to YANA participants.
- If the participant does not answer the phone after several attempts are made to reach them, a series of steps follow to assure their safety and well-being.
- If the above attempts fail and contact with the participant cannot be made, the Maricopa Police Department is called to check on the participants' well-being.

You Are Not Alone works collaboratively with community and social service agencies for a coordinated response to meet the needs of residents in Maricopa with limited mobility.




