

ORDINANCE NUMBER 19-13

AN ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, AMENDING SECTION 2-82(1)(a)(i) OF THE CITY CODE OF MARICOPA REGARDING COUNCIL ESTABLISHED STANDING COMMITTEES TO COMBINE THE CULTURAL AFFAIRS COMMITTEE AND THE ARTS COMMITTEE.

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, have reviewed Section 2-82(1)(a)(i) of the Code of the City of Maricopa concerning the currently established standing committees; and

WHEREAS, after consultation with staff, the Mayor and Council of the City of Maricopa, Arizona, have determined that such section should be revised to combine the Cultural Affairs Committee and the Arts Committee into the newly formed Cultural Affairs and Arts Committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MARICOPA, ARIZONA, AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 2-82(1)(a)(i)(E) of the City Code of Maricopa and all amendments thereto are hereby repealed in its entirety and replaced with the following:

(E) Cultural Affairs and Arts Committee

Section 2. Section 2-82(1)(a)(i)(F) of the City Code of Maricopa, entitled Arts Committee and all amendments thereto are hereby repealed in its entirety.

Section 3. To the extent of any conflict between other City Ordinances and this Ordinance, this Ordinance shall be deemed to be controlling; provided, however, that this Ordinance is not intended to amend or repeal any existing City Ordinance, Resolution or regulation except as expressly set forth herein.

Section 4. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be invalid or unconstitutional by the decision of any court of competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.


Section 5. This Ordinance shall become immediately effective thirty (30) days from the date of its passage and adoption by the City Council of the City of Maricopa.
