# City of Maricopa Development Fees Report for Fiscal Year Ended June 30, 2011

#### **Project Information**

#### **Library DIF**

The library collection is completed. Future DIF revenues will be spent on construction of a library facility.

#### **Public Safety DIF**

PD Vehicles & related equipment budgeted with impact fees have been purchased.

#### **General Government DIF**

Design and construction of a new city complex building started in FY 11 and is expected to be complete in FY13. Total project budget is estimated at \$18,707,970 and includes land purchase, design, construction and FF&E. Funding is provided by General Government DIF, Public Safety DIF, and General Fund capital reserves.

#### **Transportation DIF**

Smith-Enke Rd & Porter Rd signal – this project is complete.

Honeycutt Road from SR347 to MCG Highway has a total project budget of \$4,000,000 consisting of land acquisition and preparation, design and construction. Project is expected to be completed in FY14.

Honeycutt Road from SR347 to MCG Highway widening design

MCG reroute to Honeycutt Rd – this is for design

MCG Highway Interim Improvements – This is a master description for a series of projects to improve the MCG Highway over the next fifteen years. Budgeted amount for FY11 was \$3,300,000. The two associated projects that DIF funds were spent on are:

### Interconnect Porter/MCG – this portion is complete

Right of Way purchase for MCG widening

Public Works facility – this property purchase is part of the planned Public Works/Fleet Maintenance Yard project. Total project budget is estimated at \$3,000,000 and includes land purchase and construction. Funding is provided by Transportation DIF, General Fund capital reserves, and HURF.
