City of Maricopa Development Fees Report for Fiscal Year Ended June 30, 2014 Project Information

Parks Development Impact Fee

This fund is used to account for parks development projects funded by development impact fees imposed on new development. The City expended \$11,404 from parks impact fees for a development impact fee study in fiscal year ended June 30, 2014.

Library Development Impact Fee

This fund is used to account for library development projects funded by development impact fees imposed on new development. The City expended \$2,938 from library impact fees for a development impact fee study in fiscal year ended June 30, 2014.

Public Safety Impact Fee

This fund is used to account for police development projects funded by development impact fees imposed on new development.

Police Development Impact Fee

The Public Safety and Police DIF funds can be utilized for police facilities and non-administrative police vehicles & related equipment. The City expended \$6,960 from police impact fees for a development impact fee study in fiscal year ended June 30, 2014.

Fire Development Impact Fee

Fire Development Impact Fee is a new fee category which became effective on January 1, 2012. These funds can be used for non-administrative fire facilities including all appurtenances, equipment and vehicles. The City expended \$9,125 from fire impact fees for a development impact fee study and \$56,451 for end user radios in fiscal year ended June 30, 2014. Future planned projects include fire equipment and vehicles.

Transportation Development Impact Fee

Transportation DIF infrastructure projects can be used for Facilities located in the service area, including arterial or collector streets or roads that have been designated on an officially adopted plan of the City, traffic signals and right-of-way and improvements thereon. Honeycutt Road at Seven Ranches (South) – The project will provide for a minimum of four travel lanes on Honeycutt Road from Porter Road to White & Parker Road.

SR347 Overpass Project – Honeycutt Road to MCG Highway – The project consists of land acquisition and preparation, and design and construction. Project is expected to be well underway in fiscal year FY14-15. MCG Highway Interim Improvements – This is a master

description for a series of projects to improve the MCG Highway over the next fifteen years. The City budgets each fiscal year for projects under this improvement plan. The City expended \$1,306,146 from transportation impact fees for a development impact fee study and roadway projects in fiscal year ended June 30, 2014.
