

WestLand Engineering & Environmental Services (WestLand) is pleased to provide this proposal for engineering consulting services to build a hydraulic modeling of the 7 Ranches Domestic Water Improvement District (DWID). The purpose of creating this model is to have a basis of the water system that can be analyzed for the ability to serve future development within the DWID boundaries. As developments are built, the Maricopa County of Environmental Services Department (MCESD) will require a water system design report sealed by a professional engineer registered in the state of Arizona. This model will allow WestLand to supply a hydraulic memo in support of future development.

WestLand is proposing to use existing base maps, previous reports, site assessment, and data collected from 7 Ranches operations (including current system water uses) to build a model using InfoWater. A fire hydrant flow test will need to be performed by 7 Ranches DWID. This information will be used by WestLand to calibrate the model.

In preparing this proposal, certain assumptions were made and are listed below:

- 7 Ranches will conduct fire hydrant flow test at a hydrant identified by WestLand. The pressure and flow information will be provided to WestLand. This information will be used to calibrate the newly developed model.
- 7 Ranches operator will provide information not available to WestLand in previously received documents such as water system demands, pressure setting for the pumps, etc.
- Modeling for a specific event and a memorandum is not part of this proposal

WestLand proposes to provide the Base Water Model and Calibration for a lump sum fee of \$7,400.

Once a purchase order has been issued or Notice to Proceed, WestLand estimates the overall project time to be approximately 3 weeks to complete the model and calibrate it. This timeframe is dependent upon receipt of information from 7 Ranches regarding fire hydrant flow test data and operational information requested by WestLand.
