Citizen Ride Alongs

## 1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this order is to provide Maricopa Police Department (MPD) members with guidelines regarding Citizen Ride Alongs.

### 2. GENERAL GUIDELINES

### Request Process for a citizen

- Must be at least 18 years of age.
  - Unless citizen is a Police Explorer.
- Refer citizen to a Patrol Sergeant.
- Waiver of Liability Ride Along form must be completed and approved before the ride along occurs.
  - o Patrol Sergeant completes a wants/warrants and Spillman record check.
- Patrol Sergeant will ensure the citizen has not done a ride along more than twice in a year.
- Information is forwarded to the Lieutenant or designee for review and approval.
  - Prior to Lieutenant's review and approval, all media ride along requests must be coordinated through the Media Relations Office and approved by the Chief of Police or designee.
- Schedule ride along 48 hours in advance.
- Persons with an extensive police record (prior felony arrest or a misdemeanor arrest within last two years), an unsavory reputation, or unacceptable appearance will not be permitted to ride.
- Criminal history will be self-disclosed on the Waiver of Liability Ride Along or through an RMS records check. Criminal history checks (Triple IIIs) through ACJIS will not be run.
- No more than one ride along assigned per shift, unless approved by a shift Lieutenant.
- Citizens shall not be permitted to ride with an officer who is on probation.
- Each Waiver of Liability Ride Along will be filed and maintained by the Administrative Coordinator for a period of two years, after which it is purged.

### **Dress Code**

- Neat, conservative attire required.
- Jeans and t-shirts are acceptable, provided they are in good condition and free of holes or tears.
- No shorts, tank tops, or attire considered to be offensive.
- If citizen arrives out of dress code, the ride along will be terminated and the citizen will not be allowed to ride.

### 3. RIDE ALONG PERMISSIONS

Citizen ride alongs must meet one or more of the following criteria:

- Interested citizen.
- Potential applicant.
- Immediate family member, friend, significant other, or parent to host officer.
- Criminal justice employee (law enforcement, prosecuting attorneys, judges, corrections officials, etc.).
- City of Maricopa employee.
- Politicians, community leaders, etc. with final approval by the Chief of Police.

## **Family Members**

- Family members are permitted to engage in ride alongs with the approval of the Sergeant or designee.
- The family member participating in a ride along must be at least 18 years of age, unless permission is given from a Lieutenant.

## **Explorers**

 Explorers/Explorer candidates under the age of 18 and at least 16 years of age may be permitted to ride with the approval of a parent or legal guardian and the Lieutenant or designee.

## Civilian Employees

- On-duty civilian employees who wish to ride with an officer/supervisor may do so provided there is a clearly defined reason (training, orientation, etc.).
- Employees shall request permission from their supervisor.

### 4. RIDE ALONG LIMITATIONS

- Rides are authorized for a maximum of four (4) hours, based on officer availability.
  - o This does not apply to family members who are authorized to ride for an entire shift.
- Day or swing shift only, unless family member.
- One ride along per individual within a six (6) month period.
- Citizens will only ride with an officer of the same sex.
  - o This does not apply to family members who are authorized to ride.
- Rides with media personnel must be authorized by the Chief of Police or designee.
- Rides must not interfere with officer's duties.
- Citizens shall not:
  - Be allowed in any prisoner processing area or be present for any post-arrest process with suspect.
  - Be permitted to use any department equipment.
  - o Be permitted to take photographs, unless approved by Chief of Police.
  - Be permitted to carry a weapon unless a currently employed, AZPOST certified peace officer.
- Subject to being subpoenaed as witness.

### 5. OFFICER RESPONSIBILITIES

- Upon going on duty for his/her shift, the officer will advise communications they will be accompanied by a ride along subject, giving the subject's name to be added to the CAD notes for record keeping purposes.
- Take citizen only where duty directs.
- Ensure that proper documentation is finished upon completion of the ride along and return to the Administrative Coordinator for tracking purposes.
- Citizen must remain in police car during incidents that are dangerous or where investigations might be hampered.
- Report any failure to comply with officer's instructions, or interference with duties, to supervisor immediately.

Citizen Ride Alongs

• Supervisors have authority to terminate ride alongs, any time, at their discretion.

### Officers shall not:

- Allow participants into a home or onto private property during the execution of a search warrant.
- Allow a citizen to accompany an officer into a jail or into the prisoner processing area at any time.
- Drive Code 3 with a citizen observer in the vehicle.
